PRESS RELEASE

SIAS Group, through the subsidiary Società Autostrada Ligure Toscana p. A., has reached an agreement with Autostrade per l'Italia S.p.A. for the acquisition of a further stake (4.38%) of Società Autostrada Tirrenica p.A.

The reorganization of the ownership structure of Società Autostrada Tirrenica p.A. (SAT) lead the subsidiary **Società Autostrada Ligure Toscana p.A. (SALT)** (which owns 5.57% of SAT, already) to reach an agreement with Autostrade per l'Italia S.p.A. for the acquisition of a further **stake (4.38%)** in SAT for a total amount of **EUR 4.3 million**.

SAT holds the concession for the section of the A12 in service between Livorno and Rosignano (approximately 37 km). The company also hold the concession for completion of the section between Livorno and Civitavecchia, totalling approximately 206 km, with construction of the first 4 km between Rosignano and San Pietro in Palazzi currently in progress.

The transaction is subject to clearance from ANAS and the Antitrust Authority, and completion of the procedure required by SAT's Articles of Association.

Upon completion of the transaction, SAT's ownership structure will be as follows:

SALT – SIAS Group (9.95%), Autostrade per l'Italia – Atlantia Group (24.89%), Holcoa – Holding Concessionarie Autostradali which shareholders are CCC, CMB, CMC, Unieco, Cooperare, UGF Merchant (24.89%), Vianco – owned by Vianini Lavori S.p.A.- Caltagirone Group (24.89%), Banca Monte di Paschi di Siena (14.94%) and other Shareholders (0.44%).
