

## ZERO EMISSION MOBILITY: ASTM GROUP'S COMMITMENT TO THE DIFFUSION OF ELECTRIC CHARGING SYSTEMS CONTINUES

### TWO NEW CHARGING STATIONS ACTIVATED ON THE A10 SAVONA-VENTIMIGLIA

- **By 2026, electric charging services will be offered at 100% of the service areas along ASTM Group's motorway network in Italy**
- **The goal of covering more than 60% of the service areas on ASTM's Italian network will already be achieved by the end of the current year**

*Tortona, 14 March 2023.* The ASTM Group, a world leader in the management of motorway networks and in the design and construction of large infrastructural works, continues its plan to expand electric recharging services with the activation of two new recharging stations open to the public along the A10 Savona - Ventimiglia in the Bordighera Sud and Valle Chiappa service areas, both in the direction of Savona.

In each of the service areas it will be possible to recharge two vehicles at the same time, while technological neutrality is guaranteed thanks to the presence of three types of sockets: CCS Combo 2, CHAdeMO, Type 2. The services will be activated as part of the sub-concession with Maglione S.r.l., today second Italian motorway refreshment operator through the Sarni brand.

With this new opening, the total number of electric recharging stations currently present along the entire motorway network managed by the concessionary companies of the ASTM Group in Italy rises to 16, while recharging points now total 75 units (on the A10 route managed by Autostrada dei Fiori, characterized by a high volume of tourist traffic, there are 17 charging points).

The initiative is part of the medium and long-term strategy of the ASTM Group which aims to spread electric recharging services with the **final goal of electrifying by 2026 its entire Italian motorway network**, approximately 1,400 kilometres, reflecting the significant contribution of the Group to the transition of green mobility. **Already during 2023, in particular, the program envisages the opening of over 20 charging stations, which will make it possible to cover approximately 60% of the service areas present on the entire Group network.**

Present in 15 countries and with about 17,000 employees and collaborators, the Group's activities are focused in three main areas: management of infrastructure concessions, design and construction of major works (EPC - Engineering, Procurement and Construction) and technology applied to transport mobility.
