

The ASTM Group strengthens security against bank fraud

First in Italy to adopt Sis ID solution to protect its ecosystem of suppliers, employees, financial and business counterparties from bank identity theft risks

ASTM, the world's second-largest operator of motorway concession networks, a global leader in the construction of major infrastructure works and applied infrastructure technologies, was the first company in Italy to adopt the payment security solution developed by Sis ID, a French company that is a leader in payment security solutions specializing in fighting bank fraud, to protect itself and its partners from the risks of bank fraud and identity theft.

The decision to adopt Sis ID's technology underscores ASTM's commitment to cybersecurity and transparency in payment processes, including for the protection of all counterparties involved in financial transactions, and is part of the broader scope of digital transformation that the Group has been undertaking for some time.

The support of Sis ID will enable the protection of payment flows from any attempt at bank fraud, guaranteeing continuity and reliability in financial transactions and protecting its ecosystem of suppliers, employees and more generally financial and commercial counterparties in line with the European Payment Council's indications.
